# GARDENING BASKET

## A GUIDE TO GET YOUR **CREATIVITY** FLOWING

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

1

A Container:

- Galvanized tub or bucket
- Wooden crate or slatted box
- Woven garden trug or harvest basket
- Large terracotta pot or ceramic planter
- Canvas garden tote (with tool slots)
- Rectangular window box planter
- Decorative watering can (fill with items)
- Wire or wicker basket lined with burlap
- Rustic barrel-style planter

Other Helpful Items to Include:

Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper (“crinkle cut”)
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Plant labels/markers – wood, bamboo, or slate
- Plant mister/spray bottle – glass or metal with a vintage look
- Hand tools set – trowel, cultivator, transplanter, weeder, pruners
- Assorted seeds – herbs, vegetables, flowers, or pollinator mixes
- Gardening gloves – breathable and durable (fun prints or colors)
- Wide-brimmed hat – for sun protection
- Apron – with pockets for tools and seed packets
- Starter cups or peat pots – for seedlings
- Kneeling pad or garden seat
- Small watering can (metal or colorful plastic)
- Potting soil or seed-starting mix (small bag)
- Plant food or organic fertilizer sticks
- Decorative flowerpots or small terracotta planters
- Garden twine and scissors set
- Garden-themed notepad or planner for tracking planting dates
- Herb scissors or snips
- A gardening book or field guide (e.g., pollinator plants, herbs, or veggies)
- Butterfly or bee house
- Packet of wildflower seeds for pollinators
- Outdoor thermometer or rain gauge
- Solar garden stake light or decorative wind chime
- Mini succulent or potted plant to “start” the basket

# COFFEE LOVERS BASKET

## A GUIDE TO GET YOUR **CREATIVITY** FLOWING

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

#### 1 A Container:

- Woven basket lined with a plaid napkin or burlap
- Wooden crate or small barrel-style box
- Large ceramic bowl or mixing bowl
- Coffee-themed storage canister or tin
- Canvas tote or jute bag with a fun coffee quote
- Galvanized pail (for a rustic vibe)
- Reusable lidded storage bin or “coffee station” caddy

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper (“crinkle cut”)
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

#### 3 Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Coffee beans or ground coffee – include a mix (light, medium, dark roast) or a sampler from local roasters
- Mug(s) – classic ceramic, travel tumbler, or double-walled glass
- Coffee stirs / spoons – stainless steel, wood, or fun reusable ones
- Chocolates – truffles, chocolate-covered espresso beans, or a bar selection
- Biscotti – assorted flavors (almond, chocolate-dipped, cranberry-orange)
- Gift card to a favorite coffee shop (local café or national chain)
- Coffee shop merch – branded mug, tote, or cozy hoodie
- Flavored syrups (vanilla, caramel, hazelnut) or honey sticks
- Small bottle of sweet cream or non-dairy creamer (if basket will be refrigerated)
- Mini French press, pour-over dripper, or single-serve brewer
- Milk frother or handheld whisk
- Reusable stainless steel or glass straw set
- Candle with a “coffeehouse” scent (e.g., vanilla latte, mocha)
- Packets of hot cocoa or chai tea (for variety)
- Snack pairings: shortbread, mini donuts, stroopwafels, or s’mores bites (to match the theme!)
- A cute coffee-themed sign, wall art, or coaster set
- Small jar of cinnamon or cocoa powder for topping drinks
- Reusable coffee sleeve or wrap

# HIS & HERS BASKET

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

- 1** A Container:
- Oversized woven basket lined with a soft blanket
  - Decorative storage trunk or wooden chest
  - Large lidded box tied with ribbon
  - Sturdy canvas tote or duffel (that can be reused for trips)
  - Round galvanized tub with a cozy liner
  - Vintage suitcase for a fun “getaway” theme

  - Robes (2) – plush spa robes or lightweight waffle robes in neutral colors
  - Decorative pillow – small accent or throw pillow with a sweet saying (“Love You More,” “Better Together,” etc.)
  - Soft throw blanket (neutral or reversible)
  - Scented candles or tealight set
  - Slippers (one pair for each)
  - Cozy socks (fun prints or luxe textures)
  - Mini bottles of bubbly or wine (or sparkling juice)
  - Chocolates or truffles
  - Gourmet coffee or hot cocoa packets
  - Small bottle of flavored syrup or honey sticks
  - Book of date-night ideas or conversation starters
  - Bath bombs or shower steamers (gender-neutral scents like eucalyptus or vanilla)
  - Body lotion or massage oil
  - Small essential oil roller or pillow spray (lavender or chamomile)

# TEA BASKET

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

#### 1 A Container:

- Wicker basket lined with a tea towel
- Wooden crate or small serving tray
- Large ceramic mixing bowl (ties in with kitchen vibe)
- Decorative tin or metal pail
- Fabric-lined storage basket
- Hatbox for a unique touch

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper ("crinkle cut")
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

#### 3 Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Assorted teas – include a mix of black, green, herbal, and fruity blends (loose leaf or sachets)
- Biscuits / tea cookies – shortbread, butter cookies, or lemon wafers
- Teapot – classic ceramic, glass, or cast iron
- Tea cup & saucer – or a couple of pretty mugs
- Tea spoons – silver, gold, or bamboo (small stirring spoons)
- Tea infuser – ball, spoon, or basket style for loose tea
- Honey sticks or a small jar of local honey
- Flavored sugar cubes (vanilla, rose, or lavender)
- Small jar of lemon curd or fruit preserves
- Tea towel or cloth napkin with a tea-time print
- Coaster set or small tray for serving
- Mini electric kettle (if you want to splurge)
- A few pretty sachets of dried lavender or potpourri
- Candle with a "calming" scent (e.g., chamomile, vanilla)
- Small notebook or journal for tea tasting notes
- Tea-themed bookmark or coaster set
- A cute sign ("It's Tea Time!" or "Sip Back & Relax")

# FRESH FLOWER BASKET

## A GUIDE TO GET YOUR **CREATIVITY** FLOWING

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

#### 1 A Container:

- Woven basket lined with a pastel cloth or tissue
- Galvanized flower bucket or small watering can (adds a garden vibe)
- Wooden crate or rustic box with floral ribbon
- Large ceramic planter or cachepot
- Decorative hatbox (ties into vintage tea-party feel)
- Glass vase or pitcher to hold fresh blooms and goodies

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper ("crinkle cut")
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

#### 3 Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Fresh flowers or a small bouquet – roses, daisies, tulips, or mixed stems in a jar or mini vase
- Scented candles – floral or clean scents (lavender, rose, peony, jasmine)
- Lotions / body cream – gentle floral fragrance (rose, lilac, chamomile)
- Potpourri – in a decorative sachet or bowl
- Sachets – lavender, rose petals, or eucalyptus for drawers or closets
- Soft hand towel or washcloth – pretty pattern or pastel tone
- Mug – spring-inspired or with a floral print
- Flower (herbal) tea – chamomile, hibiscus, rose, or a blooming tea ball
- Tea spoon – dainty silver, gold, or bamboo stirrer
- Face mask – hydrating or calming sheet or cream mask
- Soap – floral-scented bar (lavender, rose, or wildflower)
- Small vase or bud vase (guests can reuse for fresh stems)
- Bath salts or bath soak (lavender or rose petals)
- Floral-patterned journal or notepad
- Mini bottle of hand sanitizer with a soft floral scent
- A packet of flower seeds (to "plant the joy")
- Lightweight throw or scarf in soft colors
- Floral coaster set or mug warmer

# BAKING BASKET

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

#### 1 A Container:

- Large mixing bowl filled with goodies (wrap with cellophane & ribbon)
- Sturdy wicker basket lined with a tea towel
- Rustic wooden crate or shallow tray
- Vintage bread box or cake carrier
- Galvanized tub for a farmhouse look

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper ("crinkle cut")
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag

- Kitchen towel – cute baking or s'mores-themed print
- Measuring cups set
- Silicone spatula or scraper
- Rolling pin

- Muffin tin or mini loaf pan
- Silicone baking mats or parchment paper
- Sprinkles or decorating sugars
- Frosting or icing set (piping bags, tips)

# NATURAL & ORGANIC BASKET

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

#### 1 A Container:

- Woven seagrass or bamboo basket
- Wooden crate lined with shredded kraft paper
- Cotton or linen drawstring bag (for a zero-waste feel)
- Ceramic or stoneware bowl
- Small galvanized tub or natural fiber rope basket

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper ("crinkle cut")
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

#### 3 Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Natural sponges – sea sponge or plant-based bath sponge
- Body & facial brushes – bamboo handle dry brush or soft facial brush
- Towels – organic cotton or bamboo hand towel or bath towel
- Soaps – handmade or artisanal bars (lavender, oatmeal, eucalyptus, or unscented)
- Wash cloths – organic cotton, bamboo, or muslin
- Loofah or exfoliating mitt
- Organic body lotion or body butter (coconut, shea, almond)
- Bath salts or bath soak (Epsom, pink Himalayan, or herbal blend)
- Essential oils (lavender, eucalyptus, citrus) with a small diffuser
- Beeswax or soy candle (light, clean scents)
- Herbal tea sachets or sampler (peppermint, chamomile, rooibos)
- Lip balm made with natural ingredients
- Reusable cotton rounds for makeup removal
- Wooden soap dish or bamboo storage rack
- Bamboo toothbrush or biodegradable cotton swabs
- Refillable glass jar of hand wash or lotion
- Cloth produce bag or reusable tote
- Small potted plant (succulent, fern, or peace lily)

# RELAXING BATH BASKET

### WHAT DO YOU NEED

#### 1 A Container:

- Woven wicker basket lined with a towel
- Wooden spa caddy or bath tray
- Large ceramic or enamel basin
- Fabric rope basket in soft tones
- Galvanized tub (wrap with ribbon for a rustic spa feel)

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper ("crinkle cut")
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

#### 3 Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Body wash – calming scent (lavender, vanilla, eucalyptus)
- Bar soap – handmade or moisturizing formula
- Candle – lightly scented (spa, floral, or vanilla)
- Scrubby / loofah / bath pouf – soft and gentle texture
- Magazine or light book – something uplifting or relaxing to read
- Wash cloth – plush cotton or bamboo
- Bath towel – oversized, fluffy, spa-quality
- Bath salts or bath soak (Epsom or Himalayan)
- Bubble bath or bath oil
- Body scrub (sugar or salt-based)
- Face mask or under-eye patches
- Soft bath pillow or inflatable neck rest
- Scented body lotion or body butter
- Essential oil roll-on (lavender or chamomile)
- Herbal tea bags or a mug for sipping while soaking
- Small waterproof tray or bath caddy (if you want a splurge item)

#### 1 A Container:

- Woven or knit storage basket
- Wooden crate with shredded kraft paper
- Galvanized tub with a plaid ribbon
- Large ceramic bowl or serving dish
- Fabric rope basket or storage cube

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper ("crinkle cut")
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

#### 3 Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Fuzzy blanket – plush or sherpa-style throw
- Slippers – soft, lined, or memory foam
- Coffee mug – oversized or with a sweet saying
- Tea towel – cheerful or seasonal print

- Wooden spa caddy or tray
- Galvanized tin bucket (wrap with ribbon for a rustic look)
- Fabric rope basket in neutral tones
- Large ceramic bowl or foot basin (can double for foot soaks!)

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Tissue paper
- Shredded paper (“crinkle cut”)
- Easter grass – Paper or plastic
- Newspaper

##### For Finishing Touches:

- Cellophane Bag/ Shrink Wrap Bag
- Glue Dots/ Double sided tape/ Tape

#### 3 Ideas of Items to consider or add:

- Candle – soothing scent (lavender, eucalyptus, vanilla, or citrus)
- Lotion / body butter – rich and hydrating (shea, cocoa, or almond)
- Foot soak – Epsom salts, herbal blends, or fizzy foot bombs
- Body or foot scrubs – sugar, salt, or coffee-based
- Loofah / bath pouf / natural sponge – for gentle exfoliation
- Handheld massager – wooden roller, scalp massager, or mini electric option
- Bath salts or bubble bath
- Sheet masks or under-eye masks
- Nail kit (buffer, file, clippers, polish)
- Plush spa headband or hair wrap
- Cozy socks or spa slippers
- Essential oils with a small diffuser
- Body mist or light fragrance spray
- Herbal tea bags or fruit-infused water mix for a “spa drink”
- Soft washcloths or facial towels
- Small jade or rose quartz facial roller

#### 1 A Container:

- Large woven basket with soft towel or yoga mat as a liner
- Wooden crate or box (rustic look)

- Galvanized tub with shredded kraft paper

#### 2 Other Helpful Items to Include:

##### Filler:

- Acupressure pillow or mat – for tension relief
- Body scrub – sugar, salt, or coffee-based exfoliant
- Epsom salt – plain or lavender-infused for soothing baths
- Shiatsu neck & back massager – with heat function if possible
- Fitness socks – breathable, moisture-wicking
- Healthy snacks – granola clusters, nut butter packs, dried fruit
- Dark chocolate – individually wrapped squares or a bar
- Protein bars – assorted flavors
- Essential oils – lavender, peppermint, eucalyptus (plus a small roller or diffuser)
- Resistance bands or mini exercise loop set
- Small foam roller or massage ball
- Sleep mask or cooling eye mask
- Herbal tea sampler or calming drink mix
- Compact journal for gratitude or wellness goals
- Scented candle or Himalayan salt lamp for ambiance
- Lightweight throw blanket for post-yoga relaxation

- Galvanized bucket with handles (line with burlap or gingham)

- Dough bowl (wooden) for an authentic farmhouse feel
